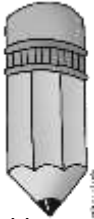




7th Grade Pre-Algebra

Homework provides practice and reinforcement for the skills being taught. To learn a new skill takes practice and cannot be mastered with one try.

Grading

A grade will be given each quarter (9-week period) based on tests, quizzes, and daily assignments, participation and minute math. A semester grade is also given which is an average of two quarters.

Based on your point totals, the following grading scale will apply:

- 100 - 90 % = A
- 89 - 80 % = B
- 79 - 70% = C
- 69 - 60% = D



Tests & Quizzes

Quizzes are given throughout many of the units as a checkpoint for understanding. Quizzes are never pop-quizzes.

Tests will be given at the end of each unit. Time allowance for make-up tests (when you are absent the day of the test) is one week. **There are NO RETAKES in Pre-Algebra**

Hint for Success on Tests/Quizzes: These tests/quizzes are Pre-Algebra tests/quizzes. They will require some independent studying outside of class. This may be the first time that many students will have to do this. So, don't forget to study!



General Class Expectations


1. Treat others as you want to be treated!
